

REGULAR MEETING  
TOWN OF DAYTON  
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 15, 2016  
7:00 P.M.

- PRESENT: Mark Smith, Supervisor, Thomas Chupa, Dennis Ackley, Edward Lulas, Diana Clabeaux, Town Council, Ruth Bennett, Town Clerk
- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A correction to the Highway Abstract for May needed to be made. The voucher for Jeremy Wierzba appeared to read \$540 it should have been \$340. The Supervisor voided check #4813 for \$540 and rewrote check #4819 for the correct amount of \$340. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they worked on ditching, shoulder cutting, re-graded some roads, helped a neighboring Town with black top and chipping. We replaced a cross pipe and grinded Bentley Road. We started blacktopping and patching, put up the new Town sign, worked in the cemeteries mowing and getting them ready for Memorial Day.
- CLERK: Clerk Bennett presented Judge Frost's certificate of completion for Judicial Training for the Board to see. Brian also thought that 9100 Route 62 should be on the sign and asked me to get a price it would be \$294 plus \$58 shipping and it can't be hung from the lower sign. Discussion then ensued about the word Court not being on the sign anywhere and also thought that 9100 is all that should be above the sign, instructed the Clerk to inquire further.
- SUPERVISOR: I received a postcard asking for comments on the Thatcher Brook study, also a letter from the Village of South Dayton asking for a letter of support to apply for grant funding for the former Nestlé's Evaporated Milk Plant. A motion was made by Councilman Ackley, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to send a letter of support. A vote was taken on the motion. Carried.
- Also received a letter from Cattaraugus County Attorney Mark Houden regarding the Contract for Shared Highway Services (2016-2021), the matter was tabled until next month when Highway Superintendent Brian Taber could be here.
- Councilman Chupa said he has been receiving complaints about the property at 11707 Townline Road and also noticed other properties in Town that need lawns mowed, Councilman Lulas also complained about the condition of 9484 Peck Hill Road needs to be mowed.
- BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Ackley to pay General Funds claims #95-117, in the amount of \$4,731.06 as set forth in Abstract #6, dated June 8, 2016, Highway Fund claims #58-71, in the amount of \$3,957.30 as set forth in Abstract #6, dated June 8, 2016. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.
- The Supervisor, Town Clerk and Tax Collector's reports for May, 2016 were received by the Board.
- ADJOURN: A motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded Councilman Lulas at 7:30 p.m., the next meeting will be July 13,2016 at 7:00 p.m.
