- PRESENT: Mayor Kerr, Trustees Ellis, Strickland and Stoltenberg, and Clerk Stockman.
- OPEN HEARING: Mayor Kerr opened the Public Hearing at 7:00 A.M.
- PURPOSE: The purpose of this Public Hearing is to answer questions and obtain comments on Local Law #2-2016 – a Local Law to Repeal Local Law #1-2016.
- COMMENTS: No one from the public attended this hearing and the Board had no questions or comments. Clerk Stockman explained that Local Law #1-2016 was adopted because the Board of Trustees thought the projected 2016-17 tax levy would exceed the limit set by the tax cap. Upon filing the tax cap form, we learned that due to a NYS calculated allowance, we actually did not exceed the tax cap. The NYS Comptroller's Office advised us to repeal Local Law #1-2016. This will allow the Village residents to receive the NYS rebate for municipalities who stay under the tax cap.
- ADOPTION: Trustee Strickland moved to adopt Local Law #2-2016 – A Local Law to Repeal Local Law #1-2016. Trustee Stoltenberg seconded the motion. Carried.

Local Law #2-2016 was adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of South Dayton on June 18, 2016.
