

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DAYTON
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 12, 2017
7:00 P.M.

- PRESENT: Mark Smith, Supervisor, Diana Clabeaux, Thomas Chupa, Edward Lulas, Town Council, Ruth Bennett, Town Clerk, Brian Taber, Highway Superintendent, Dennis Ackley, Absent
- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they plowed and sanded nine days, we got the grader serviced and ready to use when the weather breaks and started sweeping the roads. Discussed shared services with the Village and payment for plowing in South Dayton by Highway Superintendent Taber.
- We got an increase in CHIPS of \$12,118.19. Superintendent Taber asked to go to highway school on June 12, 2017. A motion was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded by Councilman Lulas to allow him to go. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard in March, 13 Vehicle & Traffic, 9 Town Law, 4 Environmental Conservation Law, and 3 Penal Law a total of 29 cases and collected \$1,889.00.
- CLERK: Clerk Bennett reported that as tax collector she collected \$101,767.21 in March. The rabies clinic will be Saturday, May 6, 2017 at 9 a.m. to noon at the DPW building in Little Valley.
- BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Clabeaux, seconded by Councilman Lulas to pay General Funds claims #38-76 in the amount of \$20,630.99 as set forth in Abstract #4, dated April 12, 2017, Highway Fund claims #34-40, in the amount of \$5,657.07 as set forth in Abstract #4, dated April 12, 2017. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.
- SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith read a letter from the Gowanda Chamber of Commerce regarding money for music in the park, due to our budget already being done for this year we will put \$200 in the next budget for this purpose.
- Tom reported to the Board that he received an email from Cattaraugus County Real Property Tax regarding the changes that Roxanne Aucoin, Assessor had told people that came to previous Board Meetings that she would make. To date they have not been made and she has until April 24th to make those corrections, she claims she has until July 1. Supervisor Smith said he has been told the same thing. The Board decided to check in June before the June 14th Board meeting to make sure Roxanne has her work done.
- The Supervisor and Town Clerk's reports for March, 2017 were received by the Board.
- ADJOURN: A motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Lulas, seconded by Councilman Chupa, at 7:25 p.m., Carried. The next meeting will be May 10, 2017 at 7 p.m.
