- CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- MINUTES: Clerk Bennett gave each member of the Board a copy of the minutes to be read before the meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Councilman Clabeaux, seconded by Councilman Chupa. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- HIGHWAY: The Highway Department reported they plowed and sanded ten days, during the warm days this month, worked on cutting brush to let the light in, patching roads as the holes appear, hauled millings to one of the gravel roads.
- COURT: Court Clerk Bennett reported the Court heard in February, 28 Vehicle & Traffic, 5 Town Law, 4 Environmental Conservation Law a total of 37 cases and collected \$2,565.00.
- CLERK: Clerk Bennett reported that as tax collector she collected \$874,586.55 in January and \$96,014.58 in February.
- BILLS: A motion was made by Councilman Acley, seconded by Councilman Chupa to pay General Funds claims #32-57 in the amount of \$108,920.09 as set forth in Abstract #3, dated March 15, 2017, Highway Fund claims #18-33, in the amount of \$6,543.78 as set forth in Abstract #3, dated March 15, 2017. A vote taken on the motion, Carried.
- SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Smith told the Board that he did not separate the worker's compensation on the February abstract he took the whole amount out of the General Fund, so he has to change the February abstract to show that \$4,208.63 came out of the General Fund and \$2500.00 came out of the Highway Fund DA9040.8 and \$6,000.00 came out of DB9040.8.
- Supervisor Smith has been working on the insurance, he says it is going up \$60.00, the total premium will be \$15,185.00. A motion was made by Councilman Ackley, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux to pay the insurance premium when it come. A vote was taken on the motion, Carried.
- PUBLIC: Angie Mardino-Miller and twenty-two other persons were here to discuss the parking and sign issue at the Master Plan Café and food pantry. The Supervisor and Board suggested that people do not park near the corners as the snow plows and trucks need room to navigate around the corners.
- The Supervisor and Town Clerk's reports for February, 2017 were received by the Board.
- ADJOURN: A motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Chupa, seconded by Councilman Clabeaux, at 7:30 p.m., Carried. The next meeting will be April 12, 2017 at 7 p.m.
