

Village of South Dayton Regular Meeting
February 10, 2021
7:00 P.M.

PRESENT:

Scott Kerr, Lisa Rizzo, Barb Scott, Lynn Rupp, Rob Killock, Jon Mosher, Linda Frederickson, Guests; Gene Newcome, Chris Miller, Ray Hadley.

CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Kerr called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. The Pledge of Allegiance.

GUEST: GENE NEWCOMB:

Gene had a complaint that he was over charged on his water bill for at least 3 years. This was due to an error on the behalf of the meter readings done by the DPW. Gene would like there to be a credit to his account for the overpayment.

Trustee Rupp made a motion to credit 408 Pine Street for 10 quarters of water billing at minimum rate. If family takes over the house for any reason, the 10 quarters will continue. If the house is sold this agreement will expire. Trustee Killock seconded this motion. The Boards vote was 5-Aye & 0-Nay. The motion was carried.

DPW:

The Kioti Tractor is down for repair. Doug Tyma was rehired to the DPW on January 27,2021. Stephen Smith is considered inactive at this time.

MINUTES:

Copies of the minutes from the last regular meeting January 13, 2021 were given to the Board. Motion to accept minutes made by Trustee Rupp and seconded by Trustee Mosher. Carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT / ABSTRACT REPORT:

Copies of the monthly report for January 2021 were handed out to the Board members, the abstracts for January,2021 were presented to the board to be signed. Trustee Rupp made a motion to accept the abstracts, Trustee Mosher second and the motion was carried, 4-yay and 0-nay. New York State Retirement was paid this month. Court is still not in session. The Village should be receiving the Sales Tax in the first week of February.

CLERKS REPORT:

All bank statements are reconciled for the month of January, 2021. Elections are Tuesday March 16, 2021 from 12:00 noon -9:00 p.m. in the library.

TRUSTEE FREDRICKSON:

I have 6 of the 8 bands booked for Music in the Park. AmeriGas is considering donating a band for this years Music in the Park. I also picked up a few items for Christmas that were on sale, they include candy canes, Christmas bags and story books.

TRUSTEE MOSHER:

The train for the Depot gate is complete. It came out real nice. I also donated an address plate for the Depot.

TRUSTEE RUPP:

Water is gaining in the water tank. Steve got the older water well to work. The Village needs a few more No Parking Nov. 1st thru April 1st for the Village.

TRUSTEE KILLOCK:

A suggestion that garbage bags go up .25 a bag. And the next billing cycle for water/sewer the rates should start increasing.

RESOLUTION TO EXCEED THE TAX CAP IN 2021

WHEREAS, Trustee Killock moved to adopt this resolution. Trustee Mosher seconded the motion. this resolution was put to a vote before the Village Board. 5 yay and 0 nay. Carried.

BE IT RESOLVED, on February 10, 2021 the South Dayton Village Board of the Village of South Dayton, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Village of South Dayton to adopt said Local Law.
