

***Village of South Dayton Regular Meeting, 2021
July 15, 2021 7:00 P.M.***

PRESENT:

CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Kerr called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. The Pledge of Allegiance.

DPW:

No report

MINUTES:

Copies of the minutes from the last regular meeting June 9, 2021 were given to the Board. Motion to accept minutes made by Trustee Rupp and seconded by Trustee Mosher. Carried. On a 4 aye 0 nay vote.

TREASURER'S REPORT / ABSTRACT REPORT:

Copies of the monthly report for June, 2021 were handed out to the Board members, the abstracts for June, 2021 were presented to the board to be signed. Trustee Mosher made a motion to accept the abstracts, Trustee Rupp seconded and the motion was carried, 4-aye and 0-nay vote. As of July, we have collected \$148,000 in Village taxes. The AUD has been completed and submitted a month early. The Town of Dayton donated \$1000 to Music in the Park. The Music in the Park has been an amazing success this year, a thank you to all involved in making this happen. The Village paid Barton and Loguidice \$16,000 for the water and sewer study. The Village will be receiving \$59,245 for Covid funding from the NYS, ½ of the payment in 2021 and the other ½ of the payment in 2022. These funds will be put in the general account. The treasurer asked the board if there is a policy in place, so she knows when they are scheduled off when doing time sheets. The mayor was approving time sheets and has stopped, I would like someone to sign off on the timesheets for the Village. Rob Killock volunteered to sign off on time sheets.

CLERKS REPORT:

All bank statements are reconciled for the month of June 2021. Village taxes to be sent out in the mail by June 1,2021. As per the Governor the utility moratorium has been lifted for late payments effective immediately. After December 21, 2021 the deferred payment moratorium will be lifted and then you will be able to do shut offs for utility payments not made to the Village and relevy those payments on taxes. If any utility customer is not paid up in full of any back payments, they can be subject to shut off. Office hours for the clerk have been change due to a change in her work at the bus garage for the summer.

TRUSTEE FREDRICKSON:

Nothing to report other than Music in the Park has been an amazing turn out this year.

TRUSTEE KILLOCK:

DPW:

The Board needs to come up with a need and wants list for the DPW. So, they have some type of communication with the guys on a monthly basis as to what is getting done in the Village.

There is still a need to clear street signs, pressure wash and paint the Court side of the Village office. Clean up Ewling Alley, Get the old trailer up for sale on the auction site, and find anything else laying around the DPW that is old and can be auctioned off.

Paul Batt wanted to know what the progress on Ewling Alley is at this point. Ewling Alley needs to be reopened from Maple St. to Pine St. Any and all debris should be removed from this area. There will be a letter sent out from the Village to have the owners that this would affect comply with this clearance per the Village. They will have 60 days to comply.

TRUSTEE MOSHER:

The gate is completed for the Depot.

TRUSTEE RUPP:

Checked in with the water operator, Steve Smuda, the tank is only ½ full, possibly a leak somewhere. Jim was mowing alongside of the roads, looks very good. The back up well is running well. B&L will be drilling well #6 this will be covered with the grant money that the Village will receive.

MAYORS REPORT:

The Board needs to think of ways to spend the stimulus money the Village will be receiving. Get new quotes for a trailer for the DPW. The mayor would like to see instead of the \$25,000 all in equipment savings, have it split between equipment savings and general account.

The next regular meeting will be Thursday August 12, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. in the library.

Trustee Killock moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Mosher seconded the motion, Carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:50 PM.
