CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Kerr called the meeting to order at 7:00. The Pledge of Allegiance.

DPW:

Concern of a tree down on Cherry St. on Friday and never taken care of until Monday. DPW should be wearing colored shirts and hard hats daily. Jim should be at every board meeting monthly. DPW only mowed one of the 2 properties on Prospect. Steve should not be riding on the side of the backhoe; this is a safety issue. There should be a “keep right” sign put on Main St. Time cards and receipts for the week should be turned in on Saturday Am. When Jim comes in.

MINUTES:

Copies of the minutes from the last regular meeting August 13, 2020 were given to the Board. Motion to accept minutes made by Trustee Killock and seconded by Trustee Mosher. Carried.

TREASURER’S REPORT / ABSTRACT REPORT:

Copies of the monthly report for August ,2020 were handed out to the Board members, the abstracts for July,2020 were presented to the board to be signed. Trustee Rupp made a motion to accept the abstracts, Trustee Fredrickson second and the motion was carried.

The Village received sales tax it was down around \$3,000.00. There is an exceptional amount of the water/sewer bills still unpaid. The NYSEG bill for the village hall has finally been resolved. CLERKS REPORT:

All bank statements are reconciled for the month of August,2020. Elections are Tuesday September 15, 2020.12-9pm in the library. This whole week I will be working odd hours due to my bus driving schedule as we have all half days this week.

DOG CONTROL OFFICER:

On going problems at 121 Oak St. with there Huskie dogs getting out and running in the Village. It has been a repeated offence. They house 5 dogs at this residence. I would suggest the Village put a limit on the number of animals per household in the Village.

TRUSTEE FREDRICKSON:

Distributed all the flyers for the survey. Unsure of any fall fest activities do to the COVID.

TRUSTEE MOSHER:

The gate is about 80% done for the Depot. Looking at a possible train emblem for the front of the gate.

TRUSTEE RUPP:

Lynn made a motion to accept the bid from Valley Tire in the amount of \$1848.00 for the purchase of Backhoe tires. Trustee Killock seconded the motion. The motion was carried in a vote of 4-0.

TRUSTEE KILLOCK:

All flyers were distributed for the survey. A few DPW issues were brought to attention, about sidewalks, DPW to remove the tires from the playground. Bulk Trash will be skipped this fall due to COVID and how late we did the spring pick up for bulk trash. DPW to paint the court side of the Village Hall.

MAYORS REPORT:

The mayor went over surrounding municipalities water rates to compare how low are rates are and if we should raise our rates in the near future.
