September 11, 2019

PRESENT:

CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Kerr called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and led the reciting of The Pledge of Allegiance.

JOHN BUTCHER AND SALLY HARRIS:

Introduced a Genealogy Project to bring more people into the Library.

The library is to be the repository for family history. Teenagers will handle the project, while under adult supervision. There will be no fee for starting family histories. People must come into the library to access family history.

No family histories will be placed on the internet by the library.

Modern electronic equipment will be utilized for sorting and scanning histories. Disclaimer by library and hold harmless agreement signed by Donor.

Nathan is interested in purchasing the Old Bank on Park St. for rentals. But wanted to clarify the clause that was grandfathered in by the Village.

That clause is they can continue to have it as rental apartments, however if it is empty (not rented) for up to 6 months the clause is null and void.

DPW:

Started sidewalks, Basketball quarts are sealed. Have been mowing and using the sickle bar. Fixed the drive in the sewer plant. Burnt one of the piles of brush behind the sewer plant. Took one of the service pumps to Dunkirk Electric for a rebuild. They would like to purchase another service pump so the village will have a spare pump on hand. Bulk Trash is coming up. Also, meter readings for the water. Rural Water came in to the Village and determined there we no water leaks found in the Village. Rays Good

Looking online for hoses for picking up leaves for the DPW also parts to clean the catch basins. Looking for the quick connect which are easier to work with. The Basketball hoops should be up within the next week.

MAYORS REPORT:

The Village is looking to replace the Blue F-150 DPW Truck. Waiting to hear from Jace Wightman to start the front of the Village Hall.
