PRESENT:

The recycle bins were emptied. The Tentative Tax Roll is printed and ready. The AWQR report was sent out to all water customers in the Village and put on the Village website. This information was also filed to The Department of Health.

TRUSTEE FREDRICKSON:

Pine Valley Band was cancelled. June 24th will be the first band to play at Music in the Park. It is a wait and see situation. A lot of the people stay in their cars, and we have enough room for social distancing. It is still unknown about vendors.

TRUSTEE MOSHER:

TRUSTEE RUPP:

TRUSTEE KILLOCK:

The amount is \$14,708.06. I will be signing the Code Red Agreement (Solve LLC) with the Town of Dayton. The annual cost is \$1200.00 and will be taken out of the Water Account.
