June 10, 2020

PRESENT:

CALL TO ORDER:

TREASURER'S REPORT / ABSTRACT REPORT:

Have DPW check catch basins and ditches. Look into tires for the backhoe. Sourewell, Steins, Gaymark ect. Have Gary Brecker look into new additions in the Village.

MAYORS REPORT:
