TREASURER'S REPORT / ABSTRACT REPORT:

CLERKS REPORT:

Office inventory is complete and the Board has reviewed the list. The next 2 Board meetings will be on the 2nd Thursday of the months of July and August due to Music in the Park.

TRUSTEE FREDRICKSON:

Asking for Ray Hadley if there was any progress on the handbook for the employees of the Village. The Board has gotten 2 different handbooks for municipalities to compare and get ideas for the handbook.

TRUSTEE RUPP:

Checked in with the water operator, Steve Smuda, the tank is holding. The tank is showing no loss at this time.

TRUSTEE KILLOCK:

Made a list of things for the DPW to work on when they have idle time.

- Get vacant properties mowed
- Check street signs for limbs hanging or blocking the sign
- Sweep streets
- Inventory
- Check on the ditch by Courtright’s to be cleaned by state.
- Pressure wash and paint the Court house side of the Village building on Park Street.
- Clean up Ewing Alley
- Get the fuel tank up to code
- Created milage and fuel sheets for the DPW to be used daily
- Safety check list for the heavy equipment and log books
- Put the old garbage trailer on the auction site
- Go through the inventory at the DPW garage and put what they aren’t using on the auction site

Also put a call into DFT about security, internet and phone service.

Put a call in to St George’s to see if they will take the lumber from the Nestles plant.

Spoke with Jim and Tim at the DPW. Had another bulk trash complaint. The Longhorns will be practicing at the playground, no games there. I purchased some cold patch from Home Depot for in front of Super Duper and have been reimbursed the money from the Village. The playground committee did not receive the Ralph Wilson grant for funding the playground project.
